



How to create a College Board Account Step-by-step

- 1. Open the College Board website**
 - In your browser go to the College Board homepage and look for a **Sign Up** or **Create Account** button (usually near the top-right).
- 2. Choose the right account type**
 - Select **Student**.
- 3. Enter your personal details**
 - Fill in your *legal first and last name, date of birth, email address, address, school and gender*.
 - **Use a personal email** (not a school email you might lose).
 - Parent Information: *legal first and last name and email address*
- 4. Confirm information provided is correct**
- 5. Verify your email**
 - College Board will send a verification link to the email you provided. Open that email and click the link to confirm your account. (If you don't see it, check Spam / Promotions.)
- 6. Create a password**
 - Create a password that meets the site's rules (usually: at least 8 characters, a mix of letters and numbers, and sometimes a special character).
- 7. Add phone number to account and verify**

Remember to **save your login info securely!**

Optional: complete profile and link other services

- After verification you may be prompted to complete profile fields: high school, grade, intended college major, etc. Fill in what's accurate — it helps with test registration and score reporting.
- If you plan to register for the SAT or use BigFuture, you can start those registrations from your College Board account dashboard.
